The following members of the ESAB voted against recommending the application for approval based on the reasons noted below:

Chair Tom Henkel – While the energy plan was good, there are too many unknowns about the stormwater management plan.

Vice-Chair Anthony Henage – Agreed with other members' concerns about protection of mature trees and the stormwater management plan, also adding that not enough has been done to address the concerns raised about impacts to endangered wildlife.

Adrienne Tucker – There is not enough commitment and certainty about tree protection, and more could be done to work with the existing terrain for a better design.

Marirosa Molina – There is not enough information provided about impervious surface area and stormwater management.

Ella Feathers – Agreed with Adrienne Tucker's reasoning and unconfident in a stormwater management plan that is designed for a 25-year storm event.

Conditions:

- Create a stormwater plan that would account for a 50-year storm event
- Construction will be all electric with an HVAC SEER rating of 15 or better
- All buildings will be solar-ready

Special Considerations:

- Create a stormwater plan that would account for a 100-year storm event
- Preserve the existing greenway on the northern border
