

I continue to use the fixed route buses when it is convenient (I live in Meadownmont). I have served on the Town's EZ Rider Advisory Committee (EZRAC) since 2018 and was its chair for about 2 years. I am also the EZRAC representative to the NSBRT advisory committee. Based on these experiences I believe I can be a strong advocate for the disability community (those with vision, mobility, and/or cognitive challenges).
