Skate Park: What does \$500K get us?

- Concrete footing remains
- Replace vertical components
- Bowl, multiple half pipes, quarter pipes, ramps and railings



Bolin Creek Extension: Why this greenway?

- Why this location:
 - Extends Bolin Creek Greenway to funded improvements on Estes Drive Extension
 - Provides continuous facility between downtown Carrboro and Chapel Hill Community Center
 - In TCAB and PGRC's top 6 priority projects
 - Meets interests of Complete Communities and naturally occurring affordable housing
- Why this time:
 - Opportunity to combine design and construction timelines with Estes Dr. Ext.
 - Conduct the design/engineering for greenway and Estes Drive Extension together since the two projects touch
 - Contract with a design firm approved by Council before the June break

Bikeshare

- The Town may need to financially contribute to bring seamless bikeshare to Chapel Hill, UNC and Carrboro
- UNC executed contract with a provider for \$50,000/year for 2 years for 100 bikes.
- Towns of Chapel Hill and Carrboro setting aside \$50,000 each (\$25,000/year for 2 years) for additional 100 bikes
- Staff is working through contract process now but want to ensure we have Council approval to move forward
- OWASA only needed \$61,517 of their awarded \$123,000
- Staff recommends using OWASA savings for Chapel Hill's share of the bikeshare program

Community-Based Budgeting Pilot

- Departments invited to submit up to 3 projects
 - \$50,000-\$200,000
 - Can be completed by 12/31/2024
- Staff promoting through Let's Talk Town events, social media, email, pop ups around Town
- Staff will share the results of the voting at May 10 Business Meeting



Staff Recommendation

- Approve Budget Ordinance tonight for:
 - Skate Park Repairs: \$500,000
 - Bolin Creek Greenway Extension Design: \$500,000
 - Bikeshare program subsidy: \$50,000
- Provide input on the community-based budgeting approach
- Approve Budget Ordinance at a future meeting for \$500,000 of community-based budgeting projects
