## Skate Park: What does \$500K get us?

- Concrete footing remains
- Replace vertical components
- Bowl, multiple half pipes, quarter pipes, ramps and railings




## **Bolin Creek Extension: Why this greenway?**



- Extend Bolin Creek Greenway to Estes Drive Ext.
- Continuous path from Carrboro to the Community Center
- Combine design and construction timelines with Estes Dr. Ext.

#### **Bikeshare**

- Interested in participating in joint bikeshare program with UNC and Carrboro
- OWASA only needed \$58,744 of their awarded \$123,000



## **Community-Based Budgeting Pilot**

- Departments could submit up to 3 projects each
- Promotion: Let's Talk Town events, pop ups, doorhangers, social media, newsletter, and email
- Results of the voting at May 10 Business Meeting



#### **Staff Recommendations**

- Consider Approving Budget Ordinance O-5 tonight for:
  - Skate Park Repairs: \$500,000
  - Bolin Creek Greenway Extension Design: \$500,000
  - Bikeshare program: \$50,000
- Next steps:
  - Consider Budget Ordinance at May 10 meeting for \$500,000 of community-based budgeting projects
