- Provide any additional input on Shaping Our Future: A Transportation + Land Use Initiative dated April 2023




BACKGROUND


SHAPING OUR FUTURE ...

- Includes three component (Foundations, TOD Vision & Concepts,
 Implementation) that establish a policy
 framework for transit-oriented
 development (TOD) in Chapel Hill
- Helps implement Council's Complete
 Community vision
- Enjoys broad community support
- Provides staff and Council with a starting point for discussions and decisions related to the LUMO Update

TOD promotes mixed uses, diverse housing walkability, connectivity, higher density development, and a highquality public realm in and near NSBRT transit station areas making it easier, safer, and more comfortable to live car-light/carfree in Chapel Hill

 Commission | April 4, 2023
