## <u>ITEM #3:</u> Approve the 2023-2024 HOME Investment Partnership Program Annual Plan

## **Council Question:**

What is the total amount of subsidy from all sources, i.e., Chapel Hill, Orange County/Home, and other, being dedicated to the CASA Homestead Gardens project and what does this work out to on a per unit basis?

## Staff Response:

To date, the Town of Chapel Hill has approved \$6,802,234 in Town affordable housing funding for the project. This amounts to \$78,107 per unit in Town subsidy and represents 26% of project costs. The development team anticipates additional project funding will come from bank financing, home sale proceeds, and fundraising, among other sources.

The table below shows the amount of subsidy committed to date from various sources, as well as outstanding funding applications (indicated with an asterisk).
