



### **History of AHDR**



#### **Priority Project Areas**









Land Bank & Acquisition

Rental Subsidy & Development

Homeownership Development & Assistance



#### **Process Highlights**

- Up to 3 applications cycles/year
- Evaluation & scoring by Housing Advisory Brd
- Final approval by Council
- Optional reservation of up to 10% for opportunity fund

#### **Results to Date**

- \$2.75 million total funding budgeted
  FY15-18 (\$688,395 annually)
- 94 affordable units developed
- 5 affordable units preserved
- ~95 affordable units in the pipeline



#### **Current Funding Requests**

- 1. Community Home Trust Courtyards at Homestead
  - Proposed Use : Acquisition of two singlefamily homes
  - Amount: \$100,000
  - Priority Area: Homeownership Development and Assistance

#### **Current Funding Requests**

#### 2. DHIC - Greenfield Senior Housing

- Proposed Use of Funds: Rental housing development for seniors (age 55+)
- Amount: \$700,000
- Priority Area: Rental subsidy and development

#### **Recommendation**

 That the Council approve the Housing Advisory Board's funding recommendation for the AHDR applications received in December 2017, funding DHIC and Community Home Trust requests in full
