


No Decision; Feedback Only









Aerial Map – Hanover of Chapel Hill






Process – Hanover of Chapel Hill



Description –Hanover of Chapel Hill

- 400,000 sq. ft. including 303 apartments and 18 townhouses
- 3 and 5 stories multi-family buildings
- 5,000 sq. ft. 1-story office/retail space
- 387 vehicle spaces
- Current zoning is MU-OI-1



- Public Comments
- Realignment of Old University Station Road

Public Comments – Hanover of Chapel Hill

- Families in 2 duplexes and 33 mobile homes will need relocation.
- 15% Affordable may not be at level that is affordable to residents.

Community Design Commission - Hanover of Chapel Hill


- What is developers responsibility following displacement?
