Updates

- October 18, 2017, Council Committee on Boards and Commissions proposed regulatory process improvements for HDC
- HDC and Board of Adjustment (BOA) have reviewed and commented on the proposal
- January 31, 2018, Council passes Ethics Guidelines for Boards & Commissions

Board Recommendations:

 HDC – Proposes that the Town use the State's Model Ordinance for Historic Preservation; supported Ethics Guidelines

 BOA – Finds proposed Certificate of Appropriateness Action Time Frame (120 days) suitable; supported Ethics Guidelines

Additional Updates

 To provide greater expertise in support of the Historic District Commission's work, the Town recently contracted with Julie Curry.

 Ms. Curry can assist in the review and evaluation of the Commission's proposal later this spring (April/May 2018).

Additional Updates

 Deputy Vice-Chair John Sweet led a grant application to update design guidelines

 If grant is successful, Town would be required to provide matching funds up to \$10,000. The total grant amount up to \$25,000.
