Design Alternatives:

- Encourage utilization of rooftop space removing rooftop as a qualifying amenity space
- Recommend 8% open amenity space ratio rather than 6%
- Recommend that planning evaluate the downsides of removing forecourt space

Enhanced Standards:

 Drive thrus be prohibited and the Commission believes it to be counter to the intention of the Blue Hill District and Chapel Hill 2020

Review and Applications:

• The PC Endorse the CDCs recommendation that Council and not Town Manager approve revisions to the Design Guidelines
