**Subject:** Council Question: Item 17: 11SIXTY5 SUP

**Council question:** Stipulation 11 calls only for “efforts” in terms of pedestrian safety in the garage. Will Town staff have the authority to judge whether those efforts are, in fact, adequate?

**Staff Response:** *The Planning Commission raised concerns over pedestrian passage through the parking deck. The developer responded that the pedestrian passageway would be constructed with an alternate material to clearly delineate the passageway. A possible modification to the stipulation might read as follows: “Pedestrian Passage through Garage: That the pedestrian passageway be constructed with an alternate material to more clearly delineate the pedestrian passageway through the parking garage.”*
