<u>Council Question:</u> What do the stars in the slides (p. 153 and 154) of the draft PowerPoint presentation represent?

<u>Staff Response:</u> The stars in the email version of the draft PowerPoint indicate the following:

o Red: Trees to be removedo Blue: Trees to be preservedo Green: Trees to be planted

<u>Council Question:</u> What did the votes for approval look like from the Planning Commission, CDC and Environmental Stewardship commissions? Were they unanimous? Did the boards offer up any comments?

Staff Response: The Advisory Boards all voted unanimously for approval of the proposed project. The CDC provided one comment, asking that the applicant consider planting water-liking plants in the drainage easement, using a list provided on the Dept. of Agriculture's website.

<u>Council Question:</u> Was notification sent out to residents within 1,000 feet? And did staff receive any confirmation that the notices were received?

<u>Staff Response:</u> A notification postcard was sent on July 25th, 2018 to residents within 1000', with meeting times/dates for the Public Information Meeting, Planning Commission, and Town Council Public Hearing. We have received confirmation that the notices went out, and the addresses were double-checked for accuracy.

<u>Council Question:</u> What was the response from neighbors about the proposal (for The Oaks stormwater project)?

<u>Staff Response:</u> No residents attended the Public Information Meeting on Thursday, August 16th. No other questions or comments have been provided to staff.
