STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

UPDATES

- Revised draft of Blue Hill Design Guidelines ² available for review; Council action anticipated in May/June
- Anticipated development applications: Park Apartments (multifamily), Quality Inn (mixed use)
- Park Apartments applicant anticipated to return to Council in May to propose an adjustment to Elliott Road Ext.

BLUE HILL METRICS

- Assessed property value up 71%
- Number of school attending children up by 5
- Square footage of retail exceeds Phase 1 target by 30%
- Number of affordable housing units permitted or under construction up by 149 (half of goal)
- Impervious surface stormwater treatment 19% higher for new projects compared to Town-wide standards
- Linear feet of greenway up 177%
- Linear feet of sidewalk up 68%

All percentages are based on a 2014 baseline; see attached report for details
