 - Creating suitable living environments
 - Expanding economic opportunity
- Entitlement community designation



CDBG Basics

National Objectives

•Benefit low/moderate income households

- Households earning less than 80% Area Median Income (AMI=\$80,600; 80% AMI = \$64,500/household of 4)
- •Aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight
- Meet an urgent need




