Cooperative Agreement Overview

- Request from GoTriangle (GoT)
- Component of federal funding application
- GoT signing similar agreement with 12 organizations and agencies
- Designed to help orgs. and GoT work together
- Defines roles, responsibilities, and procedures
- Requires GoT to follow Town specifications and guidelines as applicable
- Goal: minimize impacts, maximize benefits



Nov. 28, 2018 Council Feedback

- Agreement term (December 2021 vs. November 2019)
- Stormwater standards and management
- Consistency with Durham's Cooperative Agreement
- Parking lot landscaping
- Relocation of public utilities
- Environmental evaluations
- Opportunities for public input

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made by and between the CITY OF DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINATOWN OF CHAPEL HILL (the "TownCity"), a municipality in Orange County and Durham Durham County, North Carolina, and the RESEARCH TRIANGLE REGIONAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY d/b/a GOTRIANGLE, "a public body and body politic and corporate of the State of North Carolina" (N.C.G.S. § 160A-603), with a principal office located at 4600 Emperor Boulevard, Durham, North Carolina 27703 ("GoTriangle"). The CityTown and GoTriangle may be referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."



What Has Been Revised

- Matches Durham's agreement in structure and content
- Notes previously signed reimbursement agreement
- Specifies Town <u>stormwater and landscaping</u> requirements for parking lots
- Includes public notification and communication measures
- References Town's Noise Ordinance
- Notes environmental and historic preservation evaluation
- Establishes GoTriangle responsibility for relocating public utilities
