
## KEY ISSUE: IMPACT OF NEW DEVELOPMENT IN THE HOMESTEAD ROAD AREA ON TRAFFIC

The Council received two petitions regarding traffic concerns on Homestead Road. At the October 24, 2018 Council meeting, a <u>petition</u><sup>1</sup> was submitted regarding a request for traffic impact study on Homestead Road. At the November 28, 2018 Council meeting, a second <u>petition</u><sup>2</sup> was submitted requesting a detailed road schematic of Homestead Road.

Town staff has compiled roadway conditions on the Homestead Road corridor. The map below indicates the proposed developments (approved and/or under construction) and associated roadway improvement, including bicycle and pedestrian improvements.



A Town bicycle and pedestrian project is also underway on this section of Homestead Road. This project will bring five-foot wide bicycle lanes on both sides of the road as well as a tenfoot wide multi-use path from Seawell School Road to Weaver Dairy Road Extension.
