## ITEM #6: University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Semi-Annual Campus Development Report

**Council Question:** Will any bike racks be added or removed in the Pit Area?

<u>UNC Staff Response</u>: Bike rack capacity has increased significantly in the Pit area through the recent improvement project.

**Council Question:** What areas are next for the Campus Wide Sidewalks Improvements?

<u>UNC Staff Response</u>: While UNC is considering additional sidewalk improvements, it does not currently have any projects moving into construction in the next few months.

<u>Council Question</u>: In thinking about the visibility of practices and footballs possibly being thrown or kicked off the field unintentionally, will the outdoor football practice fields be walled off from other parts of campus, or will the barrier be a chain-linked fence?

<u>UNC Staff Response</u>: The new outdoor practice fields will be visually screened from the road, using plantings and chain link fence with fabric windscreen.

**<u>Council Question</u>**: What will be done in the area after the Odum Village Buildings are demolished?

<u>UNC Staff Response</u>: This area is planned for redevelopment as shown in UNC's new Draft Campus Master Plan.

**<u>Council Question</u>**: What kind of spaces inside would be provided in the proposed Medical Education Building (e.g., classrooms, lab space, office, other types of spaces)?

<u>UNC Staff Response</u>: The Medical Education Building will have a variety of learning spaces from traditional classroom and seminar spaces to simulation labs, student study and lounge spaces, and offices.

<u>Council Question</u>: How many solar panels will be stationed on Horace Williams Airport property, and how much acreage will it cover?

<u>UNC Staff Response</u>: The final numbers are still being determined. Current projections are for 1,350 panels across 2.5 acres.
