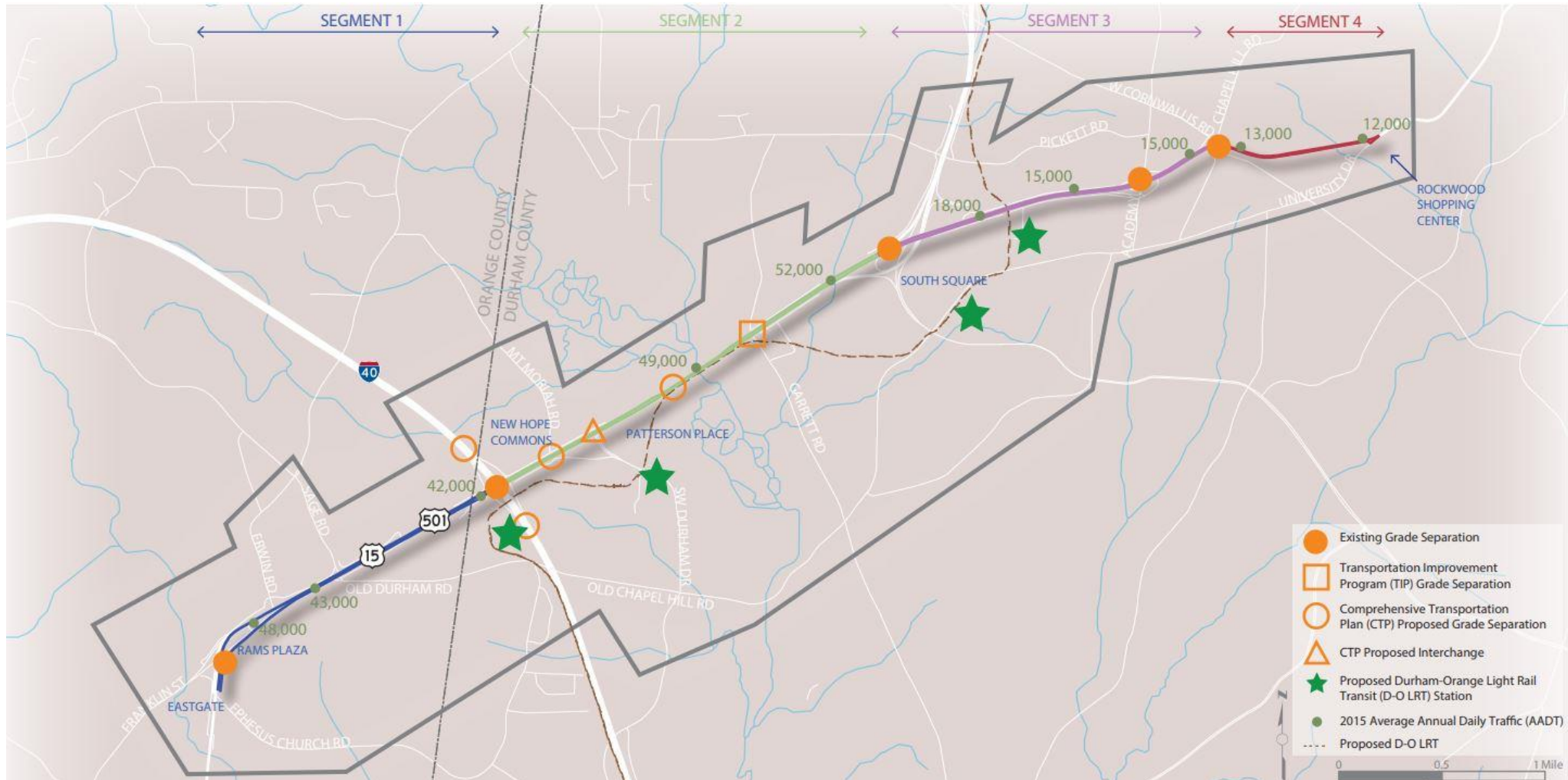

Project Overview

- Multimodal transportation study between DCHC MPO, NCDOT, Town of Chapel Hill and City of Durham
- From Ephesus Church Road / Fordham Boulevard to University Drive
- US 15-501 corridor will ‘complement’ and ‘support high-capacity transit services & mixed land use activities

Public Meeting Summary

- DCHC MPO and WSP hosted a Public Meeting event
 - October 17, 2019
 - Chapel Hill Bible Church
- Approximately 60 people attended, including city staff from Durham, to provide input on the alternative designs

- Key Highlights
 - Overall urban and landscape design
 - Concerns of pedestrian and cyclist movement through the proposed multi-use path (Durham side)
 - Superstreet concept designs are not in favor
 - Residents opposed roadway development through the natural heritage site
 - Alternative Design 3 was received better than Alternative Design 1
