<u>ITEM #16:</u> Consider Establishing Town of Chapel Hill Fund for Criminal Justice Debt

Council Question:

Does the proposal include fines ordered as part of sentencing, or just court fees?

Staff Response:

The proposed criminal justice debt fund is intended to offset court costs and fees, not fines and other restitution.

Council Question:

Very roughly, what does the court cost the town each year (I'm assuming we handle things like janitorial service)?

Staff Response:

Direct facility maintenance costs associated with court operations including daily maintenance & repair, custodial service, pest control, and utilities:

- FY17 \$22,609
- FY18 \$19,842
- FY19 \$18,251

One notable item requested by the court was the installation of access control for the facility which cost the town approximately \$50,000 in FY17/18.
