CDBG Program Overview

- ▶ U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) created CDBG for the purposes of:
 - Providing decent affordable housing
 - Creating suitable living environments
 - Expanding economic opportunity
- Entitlement community designation



CDBG National Objectives

- Benefit low/moderate income households earning less than 80% Area Median Income (AMI)
 - AMI = \$84,800
 - -80% AMI = \$67,850 for family of 4
- Aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight
- Meet an urgent need

CDBG Eligible Activities





- Acquisition
- Homebuyer Assistance
- Rehabilitation
- Public Facilities
- Public Services







Guidance from HUD In Response to COVID-19

- Reduced the public notice requirements
- Approved the use of virtual meetings
- Removed the public service limits for FY 20 and FY 21
