

Teleworking	Encouraged	No change
Bars and Restaurants	Take-out and delivery	No change
Barbers/Salons/Massage	Closed	No change
Theaters, Music Venues, Bowling Alleys	Closed	No change
Gyms & Playgrounds	Closed	No change
Longterm Care Centers Visitors	Not allowed	No change
Worship Services	Outdoor services allowed	No change
Face Coverings	Encouraged	No change

PHASE 1 – WHAT IS DIFFERENT

	Through 5 p.m. May 8	Phase 1
Commercial activity	Only leave home for essential purposes	Can leave home for commercial activity
Retail	20% capacity allowed	50% capacity allowed with cleaning/social distancing
Gatherings	10-person limit (generally discouraged)	10-person limit (allowed outdoors with friends)
Childcare	Open for essential workers	Open for working parents or those looking for work
State Parks and Trails*	Location discretion	Opening encouraged (*no playgrounds)
