





EmPOWERment Inc. is requesting a redistribution of the Town of Chapel Hill 2020 Bond Funds for the following reasons:

- EmPOWERment, Inc has a project that will add at least eight units to address the affordable rental need within the town of Chapel Hill. This aligns with the Town's Strategic Goal #3.
- EmPOWERment, Inc requested and received acquisition and predevelopment funding early this year for this project which will be located at 107 Johnson Street in the Pine Knolls community. As of date, we have formally requested the parcel that is adjacent to our lot. Once acquired, we will move forward with our plans.
- Immediate funding would allow EmPOWERment to employ the architectural team and the civil engineering firm this summer to keep this project on schedule.
- EmPOWERment, Inc was one of the affordable housing non-profits that campaigned for the passing of the Affordable Housing Bond. However, we are the only affordable housing non-profit not included in the first funding round.
- EmPOWERment, Inc scored during the application process within the range of all other applications. In fact, the Housing Advisory Board discussed giving EmPOWERment, Inc an allotment from the Bond. However, their decision changed when the topic of "site control" came up. Site control is not a criterion for the Bond funds and should not have been used to score EmPOWERment, Inc's application.
- EmPOWERment, Inc believes a funding commitment from the Town of Chapel Hill Bond Fund will strengthen EmPOWERment, Inc's Orange County Bond application which is due July 31, 2020.

Thank you for considering EmPOWERment Inc.'s request for funding. This funding will solidify our common objective to increase affordable housing to all incomes especially those who otherwise would not be able to afford to live in Chapel Hill. So, thank you in advance from them.
