# **CDBG Program Overview**

- The Town receives CDBG funding annually through the U.S.
  Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for:
  - 1. Providing decent affordable housing
  - 2. Creating suitable living environments
  - 3. Expanding economic opportunity
- Entitlement community designation



# **CDBG National Objectives**

- 1. Benefit low/moderate income households
  - Households earning less than 80% Area Median Income
    (AMI=\$90,900; 80% AMI = \$72,700 for household of 4)
- 2. Aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight
- 3. Meet an urgent need



#### **CDBG Eligible Activities**

- 1. Acquisition
- 2. Homebuyer Assistance
- 3. Housing Rehabilitation
- 4. Public Facilities
- 5. Public Services



#### **Guidance from HUD in Response to COVID-19**

- Reduced the Public Notice requirements
- Approved the use of virtual meetings
- Removed the public service limits for FY 20, FY 21 and CDBG-CV

# **Proposed Amendments**

1. Allocate \$290,902 of new CDBG-CV Round 3 funds


2. Reallocate \$235,399 of CDBG 2020-2021 to Emergency Housing Assistance and Community Outreach and Education



#### **Proposed New Program Activity Details**

- 1. Neighborhood Support Circles \$210,902
  - Remote learning support and childcare for low-income students
  - Will increase from 12 to 14 NSCs

- 2. Remote Learning Scholarships \$35,000
  - 10 scholarships for full-time care for low-income students
  - Structured online learning support and academic enrichment



#### **Proposed New Program Activity Details**

- 3. Weekly Food Bank \$45,000
  - ☐ Site Coordinator staff position
  - Supplies for the weekly operation
- 4. Community Outreach and Education \$50,000
  - \$37,674 to El Centro Hispano, Inc. for Latino Outreach Program
  - \$12,326 for the Town or other identified partner agencies for education on COVID-19 and vaccination efforts





#### **Amended 2020-21 CDBG Program Details**

- 1. Emergency Housing Assistance \$321,132
  - Previous award \$135,733
  - > Temporary assistance for rent, mortgage or utilities to Chapel Hill residents
- 2. Summer Youth Employment Program \$20,000
  - Previous award \$57,648
  - Work-force training and job experience for low-income youth
  - > The Town staff anticipate a reduced number of placements this summer
- 3. Neighborhood Revitalization \$0
  - Previous award \$197,815
  - Reallocating funds to address current COVID-19 community needs
