

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ENO-HAW REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (2021-03-10/R-2)

WHEREAS, the federal "Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000" (PL 106-390) requires local governments to adopt a mitigation plan in order to be eligible for hazard mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, Federal mitigation planning regulations require local mitigation plans to be updated and resubmitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for approval every five years in order to continue eligibility for Federal Emergency Management Agency hazard mitigation assistance programs; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute §166A-19.41 requires local governments to have an approved hazard mitigation plan in order to receive state public assistance funds; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill desires to remain eligible for hazard mitigation funding and public assistance disaster relief funds; and

WHEREAS, Town staff along with representatives from partnering jurisdictions, in conjunction with contract services, have performed a comprehensive review and evaluation of the newly- created Eno-Haw Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan and have updated the plan as required under regulations at 44 CFR Part 201 and according to guidance issued by the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the Eno-Haw Regional Hazard Mitigation plan formalizes the regional partnerships necessary to strategically and efficiently reduce and eliminate long-term risk to our citizens and their property from hazards; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management has deemed the Eno-Haw Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan compliant with Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as well as with relevant state requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has deemed the Eno-Haw Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan compliant with Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council hereby adopts, by way of this resolution, the "Eno-Haw Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan" as approved by the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
