AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A CAPITAL PROJECTS ORDINANCE FOR PARKS AND RECREATION, PUBLIC SAFETY, AND STREETS AND SIDEWALKS PROJECTS FUNDED FROM 2021 TWO-THIRDS BONDS (2021-05-26/0-1)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that, pursuant to Section 49 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following capital project hereby established for parks and recreation, public safety, and streets and sidewalks projects funded from the 2021 Two-Thirds General Obligation Bonds.

"SECTION I

The capital projects as authorized by General Statute, and as determined by the Town Council, includes the capital costs of parks and recreation, public safety, and streets and sidewalks.

SECTION II

The Manager of the Town of Chapel Hill is hereby directed to proceed with the implementation of these projects within terms of funds appropriated here.

SECTION III

Revenues anticipated to be available to the Town to complete the project are hereby established as follows:
