STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Historic District Commission (HDC) review and adopt the proposed amendments to the Rules of Procedure.

BACKGROUND & PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Historic District Commission last amended their Rules of Procedures in April 2010.

Staff proposes modifications to the Rules of Procedure that would:

- 1. Update references to reflect 160D of the North Carolina General Statutes
- 2. Better align the Rules of Procedure to the LUMO
- Update the required qualifications of the HDC members to include historic preservation, archeology, and related fields.
- 4. Provide greater detail on the consideration of Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) applications
- 5. Include an addendum addressing virtual meeting requirements
