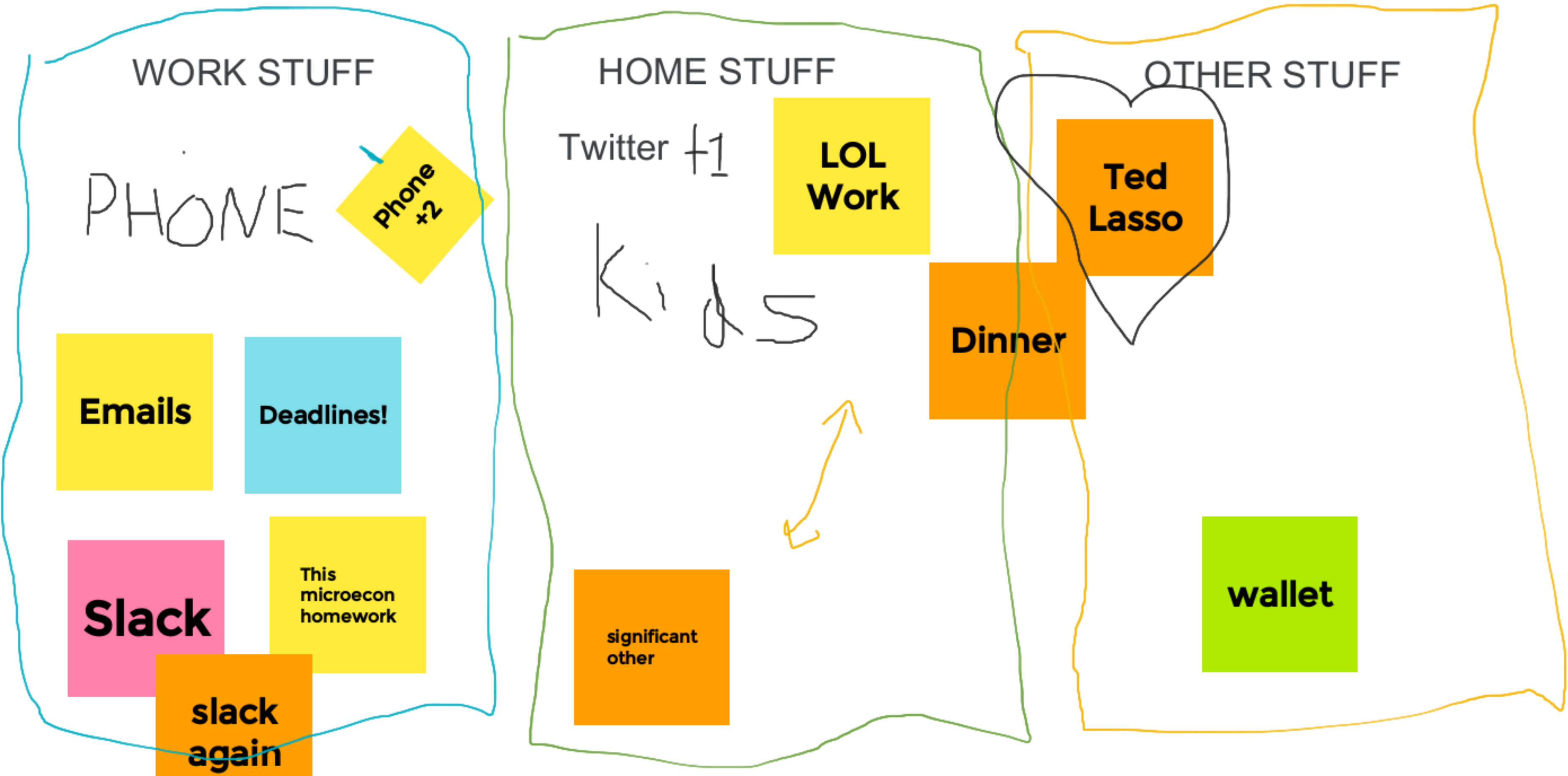

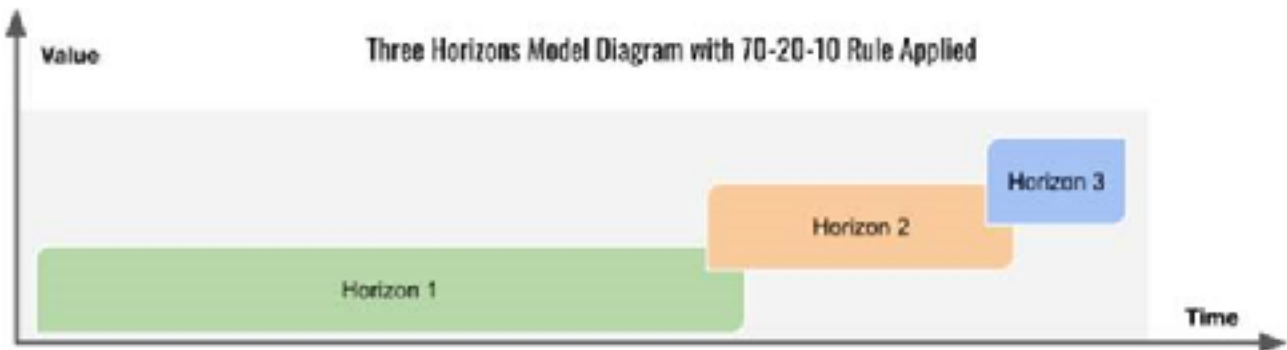
What do you need to leave at the door to be fully present tonight?

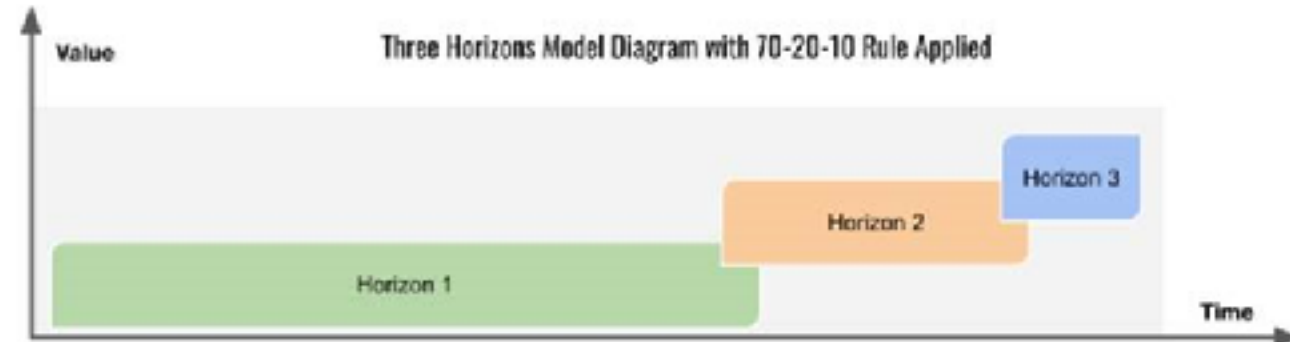

Horizon Three: Blue Skies

Goals: New Directions (proven or unproven); pilot programs; innovation; industry leaders

Opportunities that require full investment – time, energy, cultural, financial



No Car or low car streets (woonerfs? (sp))

Car trips make up less than 60% of trips in CH

multi-modal transportation facilities and routes in CH are well-designed/constructed/maintained, connected, accessible, safe, easy to navigate, and used by all residents & workers in CH & visitors to CH

fast, efficient high capacity transit connections to other regional centers (could be brt, light rail, or commuter rail)

Sidewalks everywhere. No new development without sidewalks, no payment in lieu.

second; also multimodal paths

ADA accessible sidewalks as the norm

A new signage system for bike routes indicating key destinations, distances, and even elevation information

YES

Car-free streets or convertible streets for public spaces

No right turn on red everywhere in town, not just selected streets

Protected bike lanes all over the place

protected bike lanes on all major vehicle corridors. Really protected.

community spaces that encourage public gathering

A SYSTEM of multiuse paths including ped and bike space

Sidewalk requirement for any new development AND work to install sidewalks in developed areas of town lacking sidewalks

lights, reflective painting, or path reflective device on the ground to improve bike paths/bike lane visibility

Fully incorporate bicyclists, pedestrians, transit users into traffic impact assessments.

a scenario where public transit is consistently more appealing than cars (and not just downtown)

Regional transit connections make it possible for those working in CH and living elsewhere to not always have to drive

Bike infrastructure completely removed from roads

20mph on all residential streets. 25mph everywhere else.

Comfortable bus shelters to encourage transit with connected ped infrastructure.

Coordinate efforts with Carrboro especially along key corridors. Make traffic regulations consistent.
