BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council hereby adopts the following resolutions and ordinances as submitted by the Town Manager in regard to the following:

- 2. Adopt a Resolution Approving and Authorizing the Donation of Shredded Office Paper and Surplus Plastic Bins to Local Nonprofit Organizations. (R-2)
- 3. Authorize the Town Manager to Enter into a Municipal Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and Accept Federal Funds for Design and Construction of the Estes Drive Extension Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements. (R-3) (O-1)
