### Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation - From Idea to Project.

**Overview:** Council members and members of the public recently asked questions about specific bicycle and pedestrian projects and about the funding and process for implementing them. Tonight's presentation includes:

### Recommendation(s):

### Context:

- 'Making it easier to walk, bike, or take transit' was the top priority among FLUM survey respondents.
- Town Council Connected Community Strategic Goal strives to create a bike-pedestrian friendly community.
- The Town Council adopted the Mobility and Connectivity Plan in October 2017, including over \$40 million in proposed bike and pedestrian infrastructure projects.
- Funding for bike-pedestrian projects is limited.
