BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council hereby adopts the following resolutions and ordinances as submitted by the Town Manager in regard to the following:

4. Approve the Housing Advisory Board's Recommended Funding Plan for the Affordable Housing Development Reserve. (R-2)

5. Revise Sections III. D. and III. E.1. of the Council Procedures Manual Regarding Naming Policies and the Acceptance of Gifts and Donations. (R-3)

6. Continue the Public Hearing on a Land Use Management Ordinance Text Amendment for Townhomes in the Blue Hill District to November 18, 2020. (R-4)

7. Call a Public Hearing for a Conditional Zoning Application for Columbia Street Annex, 1150 S.
