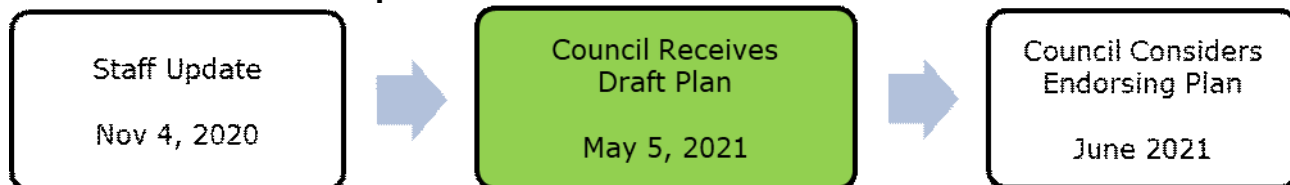


Recommendation(s):
