Overview: Since February 2022, staff and consultants have conducted a comprehensive review and diagnosis of the Land Use Management Ordinance as a part of the Transit Oriented Development (Shaping Our Future) initiative. This review included content, decision making procedures, and changes to the LUMO that will be required to achieve land use and development objectives set by the Future Land Use Map (FLUM).
