

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO INCREASE THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT ABOVE THE TEN PERCENT THRESHOLD ON THE STREET RESURFACING CONTRACT WITH DANIELS INC. OF GARNER. (2026-04-15/R-2)**

WHEREAS, Town Resolution (2013-01-29/R-3) requires Council to provide authorization to the Town Manager to increase the contract cost once the cumulative costs of construction change orders go above ten percent of the original contract amount; and

WHEREAS, the Town can resurface additional roads this year, instead of deferring the maintenance at a higher cost; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in the General Fund FY26 Street Resurfacing allocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill that the Council authorizes the Town Manager to go above the ten percent threshold on costs of cumulative change orders on the street resurfacing contract to increase the contract amount up to \$1,172,599.38.
