

**DRAFT SUMMARY MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CHAPEL HILL TOWN COUNCIL
MONDAY, MAY 23, 2016, AT 6:00 PM**

1. Council Special Meeting / Drop- in Public Information Session

The Chapel Hill Town Council convened a Special Meeting at 6:00 p.m. for a drop in public information session on the Ephesus Fordham Area Road Network. Staff provided Council members and attendees with information on current transportation planning efforts and roadway improvement initiatives in the Ephesus Fordham District, along with logistical details regarding parking and transit access to Town Hall.

Overview of Ephesus Fordham Area Road Network

Public Works and Transportation staff presented an overview of planned and ongoing improvements derived from the Ephesus Church Fordham Small Area Plan and the accompanying 2011 Traffic Analysis. Staff explained that the roadway redesign aims to enhance multimodal access, improve safety, and support redevelopment while addressing existing congestion and infrastructure constraints. Staff also explained that the first phase of upgrades at the Ephesus Church Road and Fordham Boulevard intersections is currently underway. Council members discussed project timelines, coordination with private development, and future opportunities for community input.
